Your profile is completely in your control. You can log into [Elements](#), the backend to [DiscoverResearch](#), to hide certain pieces and/or completely remove your profile with a quick toggle.

To make your entire profile public or private:

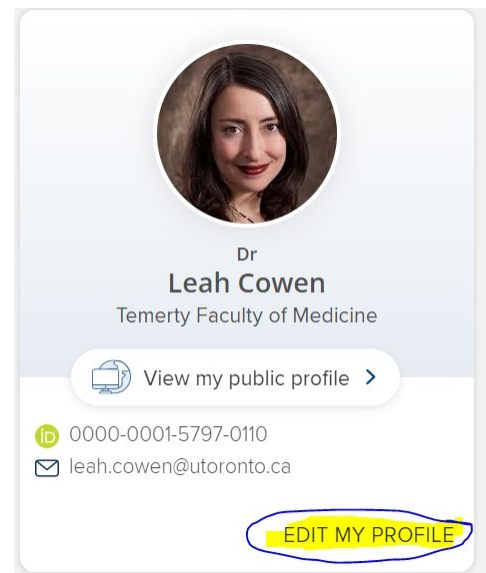
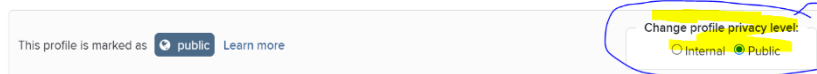
Start by logging into [Elements](#). From there, click on **Edit My Profile** beneath your picture.

From there, adjust the **Change profile privacy level** toggle to your desired setting.

To make certain pieces of your public profile internal:
